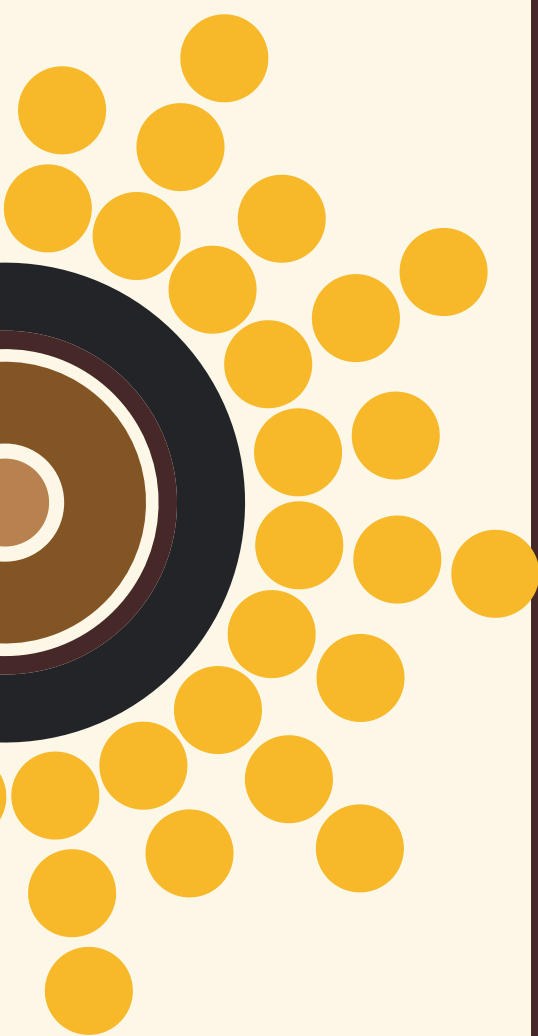

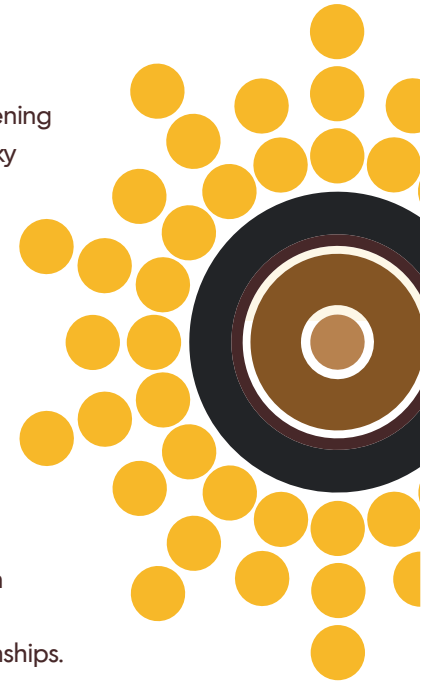
Opening Plenary

Challenging topics among Advanced sessions this year are:

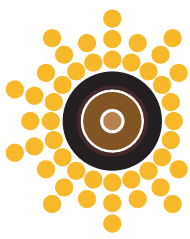
- Executive transition management;

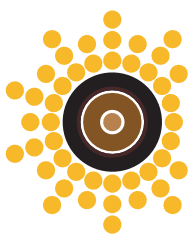

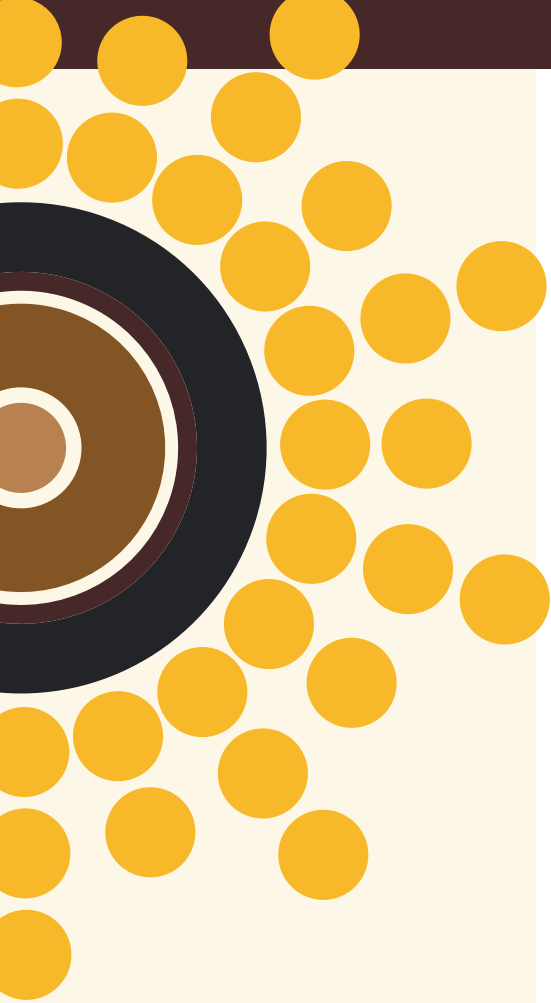

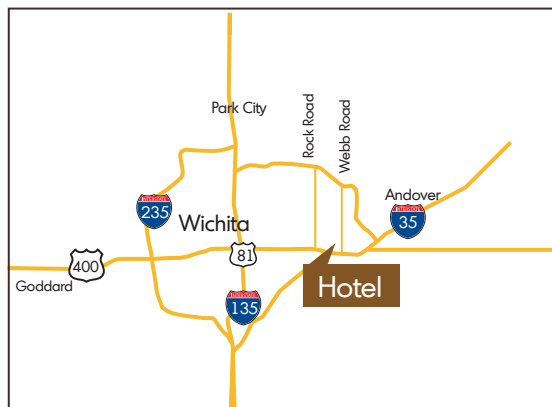
Hotel Reservation
